## Project description

Project “Let’s STOP hate speech” will be the international youth exchange. The working language of the exchange will be English. The project will last 9 days and is planned for **21-29 April 2017**. **36 participants** from Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia, and Poland will take part in the project.

## Main aim

The aim of this youth exchange is to increase the awareness of the need to fight with hate speech which occurs in the European sphere and is especially visible on the cultural background. Through this project, we want to promote tolerance in many aspects and encourage people to fight with different forms of intolerance and hate speech. We want to point out on the hate speech which is visible in the Internet, the media, public sphere. Participants of the exchange will also improve their soft skills. As a result of this project, social campaign opposing hate speech will be carried out on a large scale.

## Methodology

The methodology will be based on non-formal education. The participants will take part in energizers, interactive workshops, debates, simulations, reflective and evaluation groups, field game, group workings, case studies. We will be also working using Word café and LEAP method.

## Participants

The age limit is 18-25. Participants with fewer opportunities are particularly welcomed. A team from each country is supposed to consist of 6 participants and of the equal number of women and men (3+3).

## Accommodation

The project will be held in Wierzchosławice (near Kraków) in Poland in a high-quality hotel.
